# FIELD NOTES - HURON MOUNTAINS MARQUETTE COUNTY, MICHIGAN

David C. L. Gosling 1979 - 1984

Collections were made in the Huron Mountains area beginning in July 1979, on lands belonging to the Huron Mountain Club, the Carroll Paul Forest, Inc., the Longyear Companies, and the Drury family.

#### COORDINATE GRID

Occasional collecting sites are designated using a coordinate grid based on 1/4 sections (= 40 acres or 16.1875 ha) with 1320-ft (402.337 m) intervals. The grid is numbered beginning with the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec.13, T52N, R29W. W-E intervals are numbered from 1 to 32, ending at E side of Sec.31, T52N, R27W. N-S intervals are designated by letters from A to Z, ending at S side of Sec.13, T51N, R29W. The W edge of the grid is midway between Howe and Rush lakes, the S edge just over 2 miles (3.2 km) S of Ives Lake, and the E edge just E of the mouth of the Salmon Trout River (Map 1).

#### PRINCIPAL COLLECTING SITES

Locations where numerous collections were made are designated as collecting sites and identified by site number (e.g., S#1).

- SITE 1. The right-of-way for the power line, from the Salmon Trout River just N of the road bridge running SE parallel to the county road for ca. 250 m. This site was clear-cut in August-September 1980, and is 10-15 m wide (grid 027, P28).
- SITE 2. A foot-trail along the E bank of the Salmon Trout River running S from the road bridge for 0.5 mile (0.8 km) (grid 027, P27, P28, Q27).
- SITE 3. A foot-trail along the W bank of the Salmon Trout River running N from the road bridge for 1 mile (1.6 km), to ca. 200 m E of the mouth of Conway Creek (grid M27, N27, 027).
- $\frac{\text{SITE 4.}}{\text{Lake, including mowed fields N and S of Elm Creek (grid Pl6, Pl7, Ql6).}$
- SITE 5. Several small clearings along the S or E sides of the road around the S end of Ives Lake (R17, R18, R19, Q19).
- $\underline{\text{SITE 6.}}$  Site E of Ives Lake and SW of Lily Pond, logged in December 1983 and May 1984 (grid Q20).
- SITE 7. A small bog along Rush Creek about midway between Rush and Pine lakes, ca. 10 m S of road to Rush Lake (grid E9).

IMPORTANT NOTE: Field numbers were frequently reused for further collecting at the same site and under similar conditions on subsequent dates in the same year. The date given for a number is the first time such collections were made that season.
